Dianella Petite Marie

Bridal Star - WA's own native Wedding Bush. Hybrid variety, growing into a tall upright shrub to 3m high x 2m wide. Covered in pure, white star shaped flowers over Spring to early Summer. Hardy, water-wise, local hero. Tolerant to coastal conditions. Good screening and windbreak.

Casuarina Cousin It - Something really different. A spreading, cascading, native groundcover. Fascinating, green leafless stems, creating a Nick Naitanui type mop-top effect! Looks great cascading from pots or over retaining walls, rock gardens and embankments. Height to only 10cm, spreading to 1m wide. Best in full sun conditions. Tolerant to coastal conditions. A water-miser, that's drought tolerant once established.

Clivias - These magnificent, hardy, clump forming perennials are at their wonderful best during the months of September and October. Select from premium quality flowering plants expertly prepared by our Clivia grower. Clivias are a real garden investment and will quickly become one of your garden heirlooms. Think of Clivias as Agapanthus for semi-shade areas. Clivias are remarkably hardy and are great for under-planting in semi-shade areas. They perform admirably even in fairly dry shade areas beneath trees.

Dianella Petite Marie - This new clumping dwarf Dianella lends itself to borders, edging and mass planting. A wonderful hardy, low maintenance, water-wise plant. Small blue-purple flowers over Summer. Height to 25cm, width to 25cm.

Grevillea Deua Flame - This new variety has taken the Grevillea world by storm. Dazzling, bright red flowers over Spring-Summer and spot flowering over the rest of the year. Attractive, broad, olive-green foliage. Bird attracting, nectar rich blooms. Height and width to 1.5m. Try it for a low hedge or feature container plant.

Lomandra Chewton Grey - This grass-like plant is a hardy, tufted perennial, growing to 80cm high and 20-40cm wide. Green, grassy foliage with blue tinged new growth. Night scented spikes of creamy-yellow flowers over Spring-Summer. Great for borders, around ponds, habitat creation and general landscaping.

Lomandra Lime Wave - A beautiful native grass with cascading lime-green fine foliage. Height and width to 70cm. Yellow flower spikes over Spring-Summer. Very low water requirement once established. Height and width to 70cm.

Lomandra Seascape - Graceful tuft-forming plant with fine grassy grey-green, cascading foliage. Brings a relaxed coastal feel to the garden. Wonderful for group planting, borders and pots. A superb landscape plant. Height to 75cm and width to 50cm.

Syzygium Resilience - This selected Lillypilly is resistant to psyllid* attack. Foliage is deep green, highlighted by coppery-red new growth. A fast growing Lillypilly that makes a fantastic medium to tall hedge or screen. Height 3-4m (or smaller with clipping). Good topiary specimen too.

Ozothamnus Radiance - We've been very impressed with Radiance ever since we first grew it. A unique, ever-flowering, native shrub with a bushy, neat habit. The branch tips are constantly covered with small white paper flowers, giving a snow-like effect. Foliage is curry scented. Hardy, rewarding shrub to 2m high and 1m wide. A water-wise marvel that's tolerant to frost and coastal conditions.

*Psyllids are sap-sucking insects which commonly attack Syzygiums causing pimply looking distorted foliage.
