

WISTERIA MAGIC

Cascading wisterias, dripping with colour, are a breathtaking sight, so plant now for future glory!

Wisterias are like a good red wine. They just get better with age, producing more spectacular displays each year. Wisterias are much loved for their sensational, springtime flowering. They're extremely versatile and can be grown on walls, fences, over pergolas and arches, or along verandas and walkways. They can also be maintained as standards or bonsai, or as container plants in large tubs or wine barrels.

White Wisteria

One of the best ways to grow wisterias is on a pergola where the hanging flowers can be admired from below. Wisterias are woody vines and require a strong, sturdy support. They prefer full sun conditions and require about six hours of sunlight per day.

Discover the magic of wisterias with these classic varieties:

Wisteria Amethyst Falls - This American Wisteria is a smaller and less rampant grower than the Chinese and Japanese Wisterias. Fragrant, compact blue racemes in Spring and spot flowering over Summer.

Wisteria Brachybotrys Shiro Kapitan - Sweetly scented, compact white racemes.

Wisteria Lavender Lace - A Hybrid Wisteria with fragrant long racemes of pale lavender-violet blooms.

Wisteria Floribunda (Japanese Wisteria) - Blue-violet, sweetly scented flowers. Long racemes, often more than 30cm long.

Wisteria Floribunda Alba (White Japanese Wisteria) - Beautiful, long cascades of white flowers. This is the variety often painted by French Impressionist Claude Monet. It can be seen growing on the Japanese Bridge in Monet's garden in Giverny, France.

Also available: Wisteria Floribunda Rosea (Pink Japanese Wisteria) and Wisteria Floribunda Carnea (Pale Pink Japanese Wisteria).

Wisteria Floribunda Longissima - Very long, cascades of pale mauve-violet blooms.

Wisteria Floribunda Royal Purple (Single Black Dragon) - Single, sweetly scented, dark purple-violet flowers.

Wisteria Floribunda Violacea Plena* (also known as Double Black Dragon) - Rich, dark mauve-violet, double flowers. Lightly scented. Excellent golden-yellow Autumn foliage.

Wisteria Sinensis (Chinese Wisteria) - Surely one of the most loved garden plants of all time. Produces unforgettable displays of fragrant, lavender blue-violet flowers.
